Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Program



The **SS4A program** was established by the U.S. Department of Transportation to help fund regional, local, and Tribal safety initiatives through grants to **prevent roadway deaths and serious injuries**.

The SS4A program supports the U.S. Department of Transportation's goal of **zero roadway deaths** using the **Safe Systems Approach**.



Gallatin County was awarded grant funds to develop a **Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.** The Action Plan will identify the most significant roadway safety concerns in the region and **identify projects and strategies to address roadway safety issues**.

Completion of the Action Plan is a necessary component to be eligible for future SS4A construction grant opportunities.
